What Information We Collect

The type of personal information that we collect is dependent on the type of service or interaction that you wish to receive from our website. Personal information we collect includes, but is not limited to:

If you use the 'Request a Call' function of our website to communicate, information that you provide including your name, contact number and e-mail address, will be stored in our email system which is only accessible to authorised members of Excel Funding Group.

Internet Access Portal

As a Excel Funding Group customer, a unique User ID and password is supplied to provide you access to your Internet Access Platform and financial accounts. The information stored on the Internet Access Portal consists of personal information voluntarily supplied by customers in their request for Excel Funding Group's products and services. The Internet Access Portal, similar to a banking App, stores the personal and financial information of customers to facilitate a platform that allows users to transact secure payments and access their financial information with ease.

Who We Share Your Information With

Personal and Health Information will be treated as confidential unless the following circumstances apply:
